

- Effective 09/01/2018.
- Initial Credentialing and Re-credentialing All providers and facilities.
- Practitioners and facilities should have begun to receive communications from TAHP and Aperture.
- Applications can be submitted to El Paso Health or thru Availity Portal.



Contracting and Credentialing Process

 New Providers- Providers must contact EPH and complete the demographic form prior to submitting a credentialing application thru Availity.

 Upon completion of the credentialing process, a contract or amendment will be provided.



When to submit a Demographic Form?

Changes to your practice:

- Provider leaves or joins your practice.
- Any changes in your demographics (i.e. telephone number, fax, location).
- Changes in your contract (i.e. name change, practice name, TIN change).
- When submitting a Credentialing Application via Availity or directly to El Paso Health.


El Paso Health is Going Green 💸

- Effective 1/1/2019, Remittance Advice (RA) reports will no longer be printed and mailed.
- Available electronically via the El Paso Health online Provider Portal.
 - Must have an Administrative account in order to access RAs.
 - Standard users may contact Provider Relations at 915-532-3778 ext. 1507 to request Administrative user rights.
- RAs are also available via 835 files through a clearing house.


Texas Medicaid Provider Re-enrollment

- Requirement of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA).
- Must re-enroll with the state to ensure Texas Provider Identifier (TPI) is current.
- Failure to re-enroll on time will cause payments to cease for that timeframe.



License/Certification Update

- Providers are required to submit any license/certification updates to TMHP.
- Failure to provide update on time will cause payment delay.
- Claim denials will not be re-processed until license/certification has been updated.

CHIP Pharmacy Prior Authorization Requirements

- Effective 11/1/2018, CHIP Prior Authorization (PA) requirements are to align with STAR Medicaid PA requirements for certain drug classifications.
- Clinical PAs will assist in ensuring appropriate patient use and patient safety.


In-network Provider Referrals

- Primary Care Physician (PCP) is responsible for coordinating appropriate referrals.
- Closed specialty network: PCP should refer members to EPH network specialists only.
- Ensures care is delivered in the most clinically suitable and cost-effective setting.
- Referral not required for a member to see an OB/GYN provider.
- Out-of-network referrals must be justified and deemed medically necessary.

- Medical record data is needed in addition to claims and encounter data for a select number of measures.
- Provider packets with list of members and minimum documentation requirements have been sent out.
- Provider participation is mandatory, as per terms of your Provider contract.
- Time sensitive project- records must be returned by deadline, February 22, 2019.

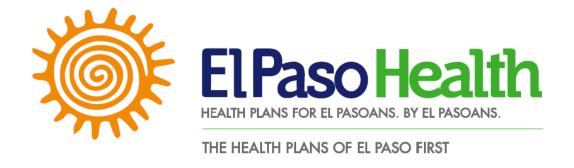

HHSC Marketing Guidelines

- UMCM Policy Chapters
 - Chapter 4.3 Marketing and Member Policy
- MCOs must inform their Network Providers of, and Network Providers are required to comply with, the marketing policies.
- Providers must not recommend one MCO over another, offer patients Incentives to select one MCO over another, or assist with the decision to select an MCO.



Program Providers

Providers may:

- Inform patients about the CHIP and Medicaid Programs in which they participate.
- Inform patients of the benefits and services offered through the MCOs in which they participate.
- Give patients information to contact the MCOs if requested.
- Distribute Applications to families of uninsured children and assist with their completion.
- Direct patients to enroll in the CHIP and Medicaid Programs by calling the HHSC ASC.

Program Providers Cont.

- Providers must:
 - Distribute or display Health-related Materials for all contracted MCOs or none at all.
 - Posters must be no larger than 16" x 24".
 - Health-related Materials may have MCO name, logo, and contact information.
 - Provider may choose which items to distribute or display as long as there is at least 1 item from each contracted MCO.
 - Display stickers submitted by all contracted MCOs or none at all.
 - Stickers cannot be larger than 5" x 7" or indicate anything more than "MCO is accepted or welcomed here."

Texas Providers Marketing Guidelines

- Texas Providers Marketing Guidelines
- These guidelines are intended to assist providers in assessing their compliance with the rules and provide information on the option of submitting provider marketing to HHSC for review and approval.



Texas Providers Marketing Guidelines Cont.

Specific Guidelines

1	Provider must comply with its applicable licensing agency's laws and regulations, including any related to marketing and advertising.
2	Provider must comply with applicable state and federal laws and regulations, contractual requirements, and other guidance documents.
3	Provider must comply with provider's contract requirements regarding the use of HHSC's, the State's, or an HHS Agency's name in a media release, public announcement, or other public disclosure.
4	Marketing materials must be written at or below a sixth grade reading level.
5	Marketing materials that target the client community must be available in English and Spanish. In addition, any languages of other major population groups in Texas must be made available if requested by a client.
6	Marketing materials must include the name of the provider and the provider's office location and address.
6	Marketing materials must not be misleading, inaccurate, or contain misrepresentations.
7	Marketing materials must not make false, misleading, or inaccurate statements relating to services or benefits.
8	Marketing materials must not represent that services will be provided at no cost when a Medicaid provider will seek remuneration.
9	Marketing materials must not offer a Medicaid client or client's parent/legal representative any financial gain or incentives.
10	Marketing materials must not portray competitors or other providers in a negative manner.
11	Marketing materials must not contain the HHSC logos or insignias, or make any assertion or statement of endorsement by federal or state governmental agencies.

OIG Special Advisory Bulletin

Advisory from the Texas Health and Human Services Commission
 Office of Inspector General (HHSC OIG)

April 3, 2013



OIG Special Advisory Bulletin Cont.

- 1. HHSC OIG interprets the prohibitions in 1 TAC §371.1669 to prohibit providers from offering beneficiaries any items or services to influence or induce their health care decisions. HHSC OIG presumes that in most instances, items that do not exceed \$10 individually and \$25 in the aggregate annually per patient were not provided to influence a beneficiary's decisions.
- 2. Any items a provider offers to a beneficiary must be directly related to the provider's profession. For example, a dentist may offer tooth decay prevention items (a toothbrush, toothpaste, floss and similar items) each visit. Although they may be well-meaning, items such as backpacks, school supplies and similar items are not permissible.
- 3. Cash, cash equivalents and gift cards in any amount, even if directly related to the provider's profession, are never permissible. For example, a gift card to a discount store is impermissible, even if offered by a dentist and restricted to the purchase of dental items.


Accelerated Services



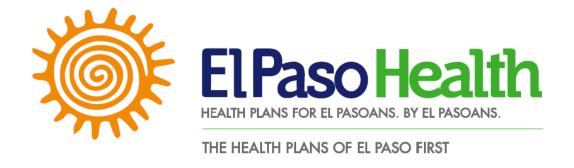

• STAT – Referring to a diagnostic or therapeutic procedure that is to be performed immediately.



- El Paso Health does not require prior authorization for family planning services sterilization.
- Tubal Ligation Procedure codes 58600, 58615, 58670, or 58671.
- Effective November 1, 2018, procedure codes A4264 and 58565 will no longer be a benefit of the Family Planning Program and the Healthy Texas Women Program.



Covered Benefit -17P Hydroxyprogesterone

- Covered benefit for STAR/CHIP.
- Complete and submit Texas Standard PA Form.
- Criteria needs to be met (Section 4.1.12 of the TMPPM).
- Documentation needs to reflect members history of preterm delivery, to include date of birth and gestational age at the time of delivery.
- Current Estimated Date of Delivery and Gestational Age.





 - Indicating page 1 of X





Top 10 Claim Denial Reasons

- Submission Window Exceeded.
- Duplicate Mem/DOS/Service code/Pay To/Rendering Phys/Modifier.
- Authorization not found.
- Benefit is excluded from benefit plan.
- Benefit requires authorization.
- Missing or invalid NDC code.
- Invalid diagnosis code for benefit.
- Member does NOT meet age criteria for term.
- Duplicate Claim (Same Provider/Member/DOS).
- Claim and contract term modifiers do NOT match.



Hospital Reimbursement for Immediate Postpartum LARC

Billing Requirements

- Hospitals may receive additional reimbursement for the insertion of a LARC immediately postpartum using the following procedure codes:
 - J7296
 - J7297
 - J7298
 - J7300
 - J7301
- Hospital/Facility providers must submit an outpatient claim with the appropriate procedure code for contraceptive device in addition to the inpatient claim for the delivery services.



FQHC Reimbursement for LARC

Billing Requirements

- FQHCs may receive reimbursement for the following procedure codes in addition to the FQHC encounter payment:
 - J7296
 - J7297
 - J7298
 - J7300
 - J7301
 - J7307
- 340B Pharmacy's must use modifier U8 when submitting claims for 340B clinician-administered drugs.



Coordination of Benefits for OB Services STAR / CHIP

- Claims are billed fee-for-service.
- Primary carrier Explanation of Benefits (EOB) is required.
