COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Procedure Codes 0124A, & 0134A Benefits for

RE: Medicaid & CHIP

> Effective for dates of service on or after August 31, 2022, in accordance with the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's Emergency Use Authorization, COVID-19 vaccine administration codes 0124A and 0134A are benefits of Medicaid and CHIP for the administration of the following:

- Pfizer COVID-19 Omicron-specific booster vaccine to individuals 12 years of age and older ·
- Moderna COVID-19 Omicron-specific booster vaccine to individuals 18 years of age and older.

The Health and Human Services Commission will cover procedure codes 0124A and 0134A as non-risk payments.

Vaccine procedure codes 91312 and 91313 are informational only while the vaccines are distributed to providers free of charge.

Procedure codes 0124A and 0134A are benefits of Medicaid and CHIP for

MEMORANDUM

As of August 31, 2022, procedure code M0201 (COVID-19 vaccine administration inside a patient's home) can be billed in the home setting with procedure code 0124A or 0134A.

Managed care organizations (MCOs) must reprocess affected claims submitted with these procedure codes and date of service on or after August 31, 2022. Providers are not required to appeal the claims unless they are denied for additional reasons after the claims reprocessing is complete. Providers may bill MCOs retroactively for COVID-19 vaccine administration codes 0124A and 0134A for individuals 12 years of age and older and 18 years of age and older, respectively.
