COURSE DESCRIPTION This summit is designed to encourage a national conversation on current challenges and future solutions by involving a national group of stakeholders in exploring the current state of the access pathway for under-represented students in medical education. Participants will engage in deconstructing the M.D./M.D.-Ph.D. pathway to identify ways to increase diversity in medicine. Plans for the summit include:

- Synergize and coalesce individuals around a shared vision for addressing the biomedical education pathway
- Form a coalition of individuals who are working in diversity in medical education to advance pathway initiatives, establish success metrics and goals
- Launch a forum for regular meetings of this group to report on progress and make future plans
- Prepare "proceedings" of the conference for broad distribution and engagement of customers, stakeholders, learners, and others

COURSE FORMAT Didactic lectures, panel discussions, and Q & A sessions. Active audience participation is strongly encouraged.

TARGET AUDIENCE Physicians and physician/scientists, high school STEM education faculty and administrators, medical education leaders, funders, medical education policy makers, and community pathway organizations.
