Measure	How to Improve HEDIS scores
<p><b>WCC</b> Weight Assessment &amp; Counseling for Nutrition &amp; Physical Activity for Children/Adolescents</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Include BMI Percentile (not a range, &gt;95 or “High/Low”) and plotted growth chart</li> <li>• Include Height and Weight</li> <li>• Include Anticipatory Guidance or checklist for Diet and Exercise</li> <li>• Documentation of “appetite” does not meet criteria</li> </ul>
<p><b>W30</b> Well Child Visits in the first 30 months of life • 6 or more visits for children who turned 15 months • 2 or more visits from age 15 months to 30 months</p> <p><b>WCV</b> Child and Adolescent Well Care Visits • 1 visit annually for ages 3-21 yrs</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Include “Developing Appropriately or Normal Development” for Physical and Mental Development History</li> <li>• Include allergies, medications, immunization status and health history</li> <li>• Complete Head to Toe Physical Examination should be documented</li> <li>• Include health education/anticipatory guidance provided</li> </ul>
<p><b>CIS</b> Childhood Immunization Status (by 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Review immunization record before every visit and administer needed vaccines</li> <li>• Recommend and administer Annual Flu Immunization</li> <li>• Complete Rotavirus series</li> </ul>
<p><b>IMA</b> Immunizations for Adolescents (by 13<sup>th</sup> birthday)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete HPV series between 9<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthday</li> <li>• One Tdap between 10<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthday</li> <li>• One Meningococcal serogroups A,C,W,Y between 11<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthday</li> </ul>
<p><b>PPC</b> Prenatal and Postpartum Care</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prenatal care in the first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment</li> <li>• Postpartum visit on or between 7 and 84 days after delivery with notation of “postpartum care”</li> </ul>
<p><b>CDC</b> Comprehensive Diabetes Care</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Include most recent HbA1c level (goal &lt;8%)</li> <li>• Include most recent blood pressure (goal &lt;140/90)</li> <li>• Include B/P taken by member with any digital device for remote monitoring</li> </ul>
<p><b>CBP</b> Controlling High Blood Pressure</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Include most recent blood pressure (goal &lt;140/90)</li> <li>• Include B/P taken by member with any digital device for remote monitoring</li> </ul>
