Update: Mosquito Repellent Benefit for Zika Virus Prevention Renewed

The Texas Health and Human Services Commission has renewed the mosquito repellent benefit for Zika virus prevention for all programs previously covered by the benefit, including Fee for Service Texas Medicaid, Medicaid Managed Care (MCO), Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), the Healthy Texas Women (HTW) Program, and the Children with Special Health Care Needs (CSHCN) Program. This also includes the Texas Standing Order for Medicaid and CHIP eligible individuals.

## The renewed benefit begins May 1, 2017 and continues through December 31, 2017.
